Scholarship Timeline

1. Application available September 1, 2018.
2. Application Deadline November 15, 2018.
3. Applications reviewed for completeness, compliance with instructions, eligibility.
4. Finalists provide supplemental information in February 2019.
5. Finalist applications read, evaluated, ranked in March 2019.
6. Scholarships awarded by the Grant Committee in April 2019.

Historically, about one-third of eligible applicants are awarded scholarships.

Eligibility Requirements

1. Must be a citizen of the United States.
2. Must attend an eligible public high school.
3. Must be a student in the high school graduating class.
4. Must have achieved a 3.50 CGPA or higher.
5. Must score 23 or higher on the ACT (Composite Score); or 1,150 or higher on the SAT (Total Score.)
6. Must enroll at an eligible four year college or university the fall semester following high school graduation.
7. Must work 240 hours in the twelve months prior to the start of each academic year of college.
8. **Must complete the FAFSA in 2018.**
EFC must be less than \$6,500.
9. Must apply for eligible Federal and State grants.
10. Must not have been convicted of a felony.

The Hagan Scholarship is a nationwide need-based merit scholarship. Recipients must graduate from a public high school located in a county in the United States having fewer than 50,000 residents. The scholarship provides up to \$6,000 each semester for up to 8 consecutive semesters. Six hundred twenty two Hagan Scholars from 37 states currently attend 236 colleges and universities.
