Details are listed below regarding what each grade level will be doing during remote learning. REMOTE LEARNING

- Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th teachers are sending home packets for their students to complete. Students that have access to the internet are encouraged to complete 30 minutes of Dreambox and Lexia each day. Teachers will be contacting students each day via Zoom, Google Meets, Remind or call.
- 5th and 6th students will be bringing home their computers and packets. They will complete work in Google Classroom, packets, complete 30 minutes of Dreambox and Lexia, and attend daily Google Meets. Teachers will be contacting students that don't attend the Google Meets via Remind or call.
- All staff will be in the building while students are during remote learning. Please feel free to contact the school, if you need to contact your child's teacher.
- Staff that are absent might cancel their Google Meets/ Zoom Meeting.
